Project

This re-roof project for the Berea City School District was economical and environmentally responsible. Eleven of 14 buildings in the district had roof leaks. STS financing, in conjunction with Ohio House Bill 254, allowed the district to finance energy improvements with proven paybacks. SPF roofing systems delivered the required R-11 insulation requirements and energy-savings benefits.

Specifications

- Remove 385,000 square feet of roofing material, including existing BUR and EPDM membrane.
- Recycle a significant portion of the EPDM tear-off.
- Apply a 1.5" of spray polyurethane foam (SPF) over 522,595 square feet on multiple buildings.
- Apply 20-mills of silicone coating and broadcast roofing granules.
- Use environmentally responsible products and processes when possible.

Implementation

The West Roofing crew completed this project in eight weeks. Roof removal included wet-vacuuming existing BUR and EPDM tear-off. Over 10,000 square feet of the EPDM removed from Berea City schools was recycled. Approximately 15,000 square feet of the applied SPF was 25% soy-based and 396,000 square feet of the applied silicone coating was solvent free.

Customer Benefits

In addition to all of these buildings benefiting from cost-effective, watertight, and durable SPF roofing systems, West Roofing's installation of System 14™ from West Development Group (WDG) showcased ways that environmental responsibility can be applied to large-scale roof installations. No other roofing system qualified with the short-term payback on energy savings resulting from the R-11 insulation rating. The recycled EPDM diverted from landfills was reused in new roofing products, such as WDG's R2R™ silicone coating. The WDG solvent-free silicone coating used on 396,000 square feet of roof area prevented the release of approximately 3,000 gallons of solvent into the atmosphere. The soy-based SPF contained 25% renewable agricultural-based content.
